Data can be viewed on screen and exported to PDF format for viewing, printing or archiving.

To configure, manage, cancel and assign new payments.

Installation Requirements

Nordia Media Point is normally installed on a Windows PC or Linux Server with the database installed on the same hardware. For small to medium sized companies Nordia suggests using MySQL which is free. For larger systems with a large number of transactions Nordia recommends Oracle database version 9 or higher.

Alternatively, the system can be provided as a remote installation on a virtual server with absolutely no installation requirements on client site.
